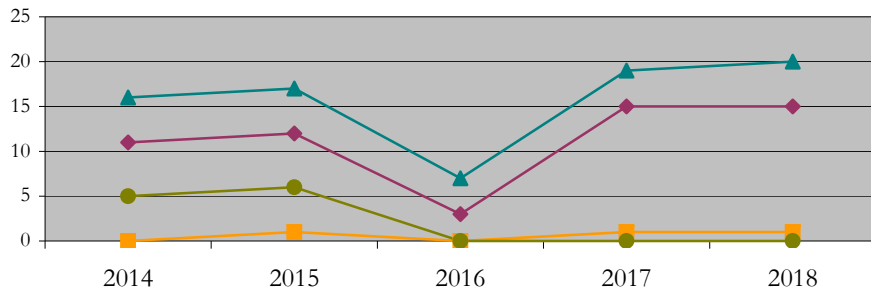

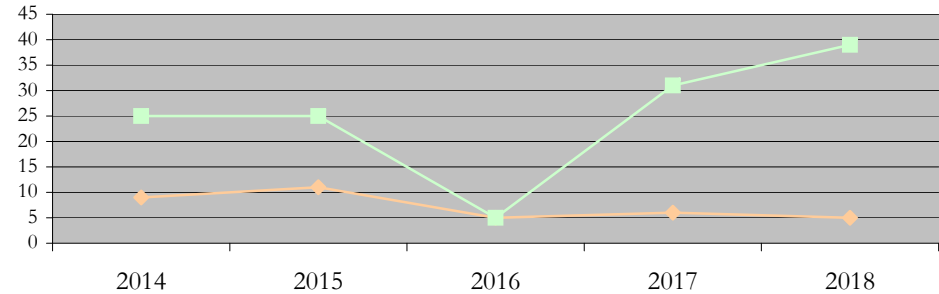

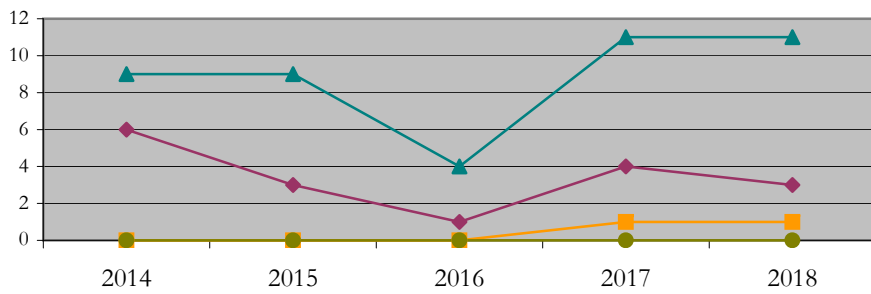
Applications by Race/Ethnicity



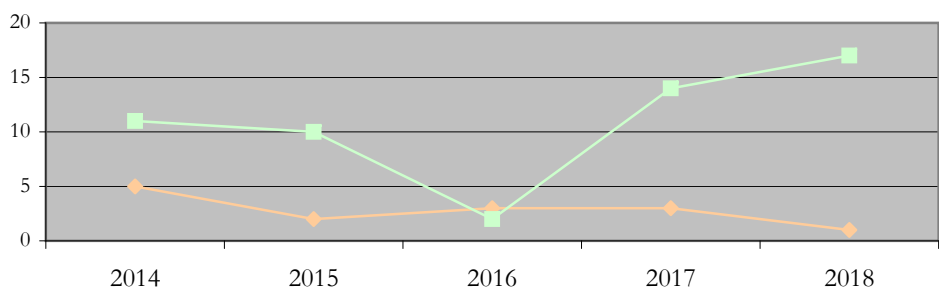
Applications by Gender



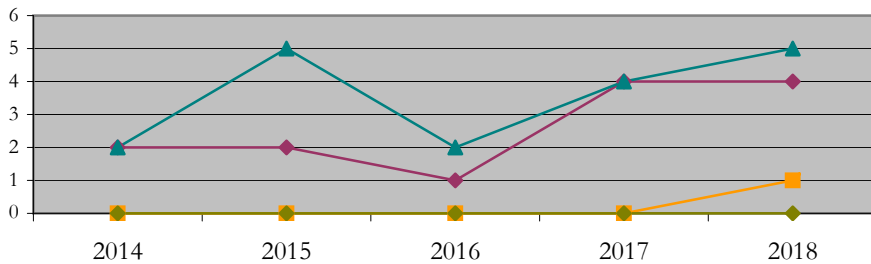
Admissions by Race/Ethnicity



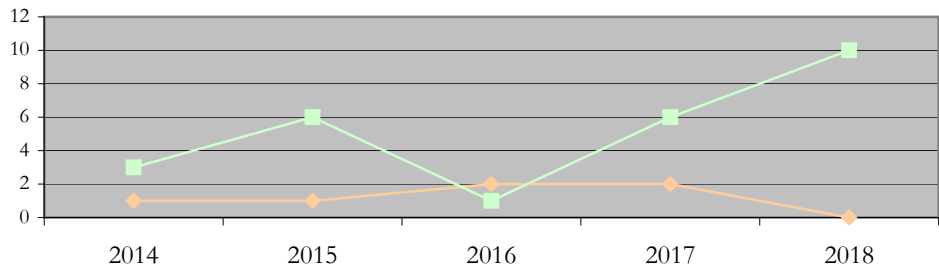
Admissions by Gender

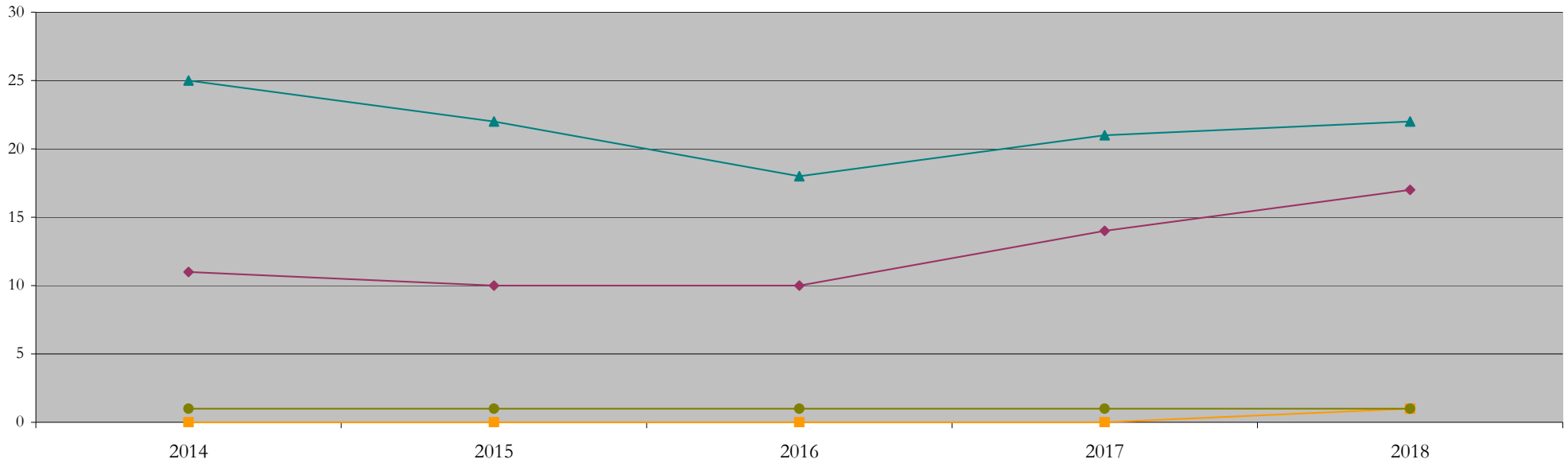

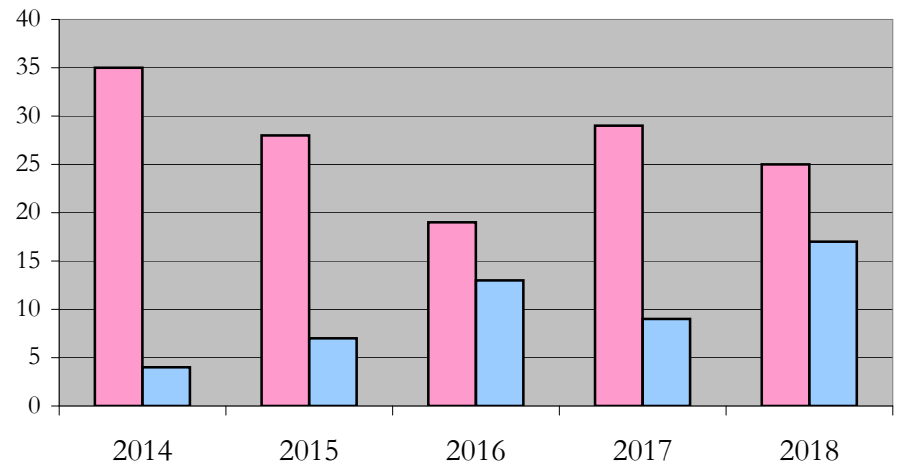

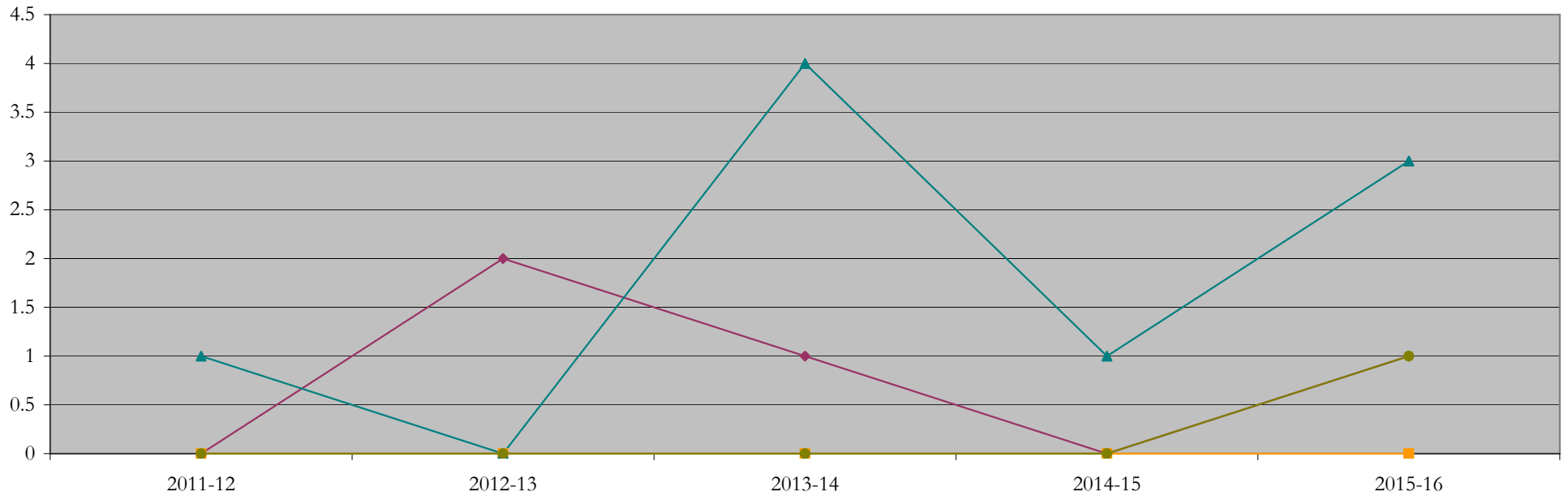
